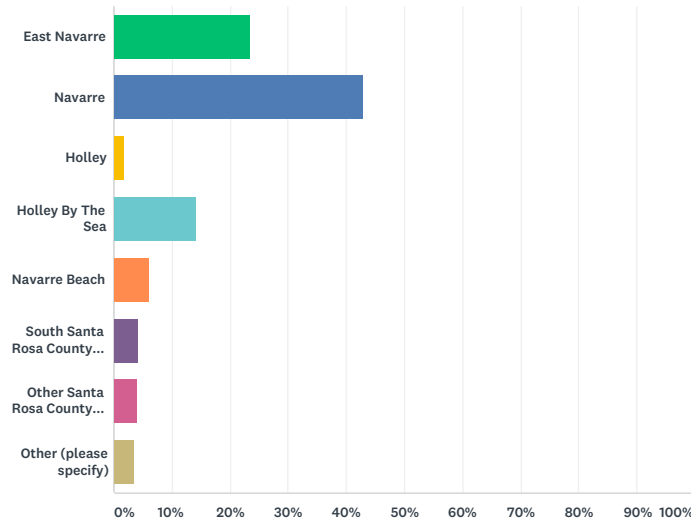

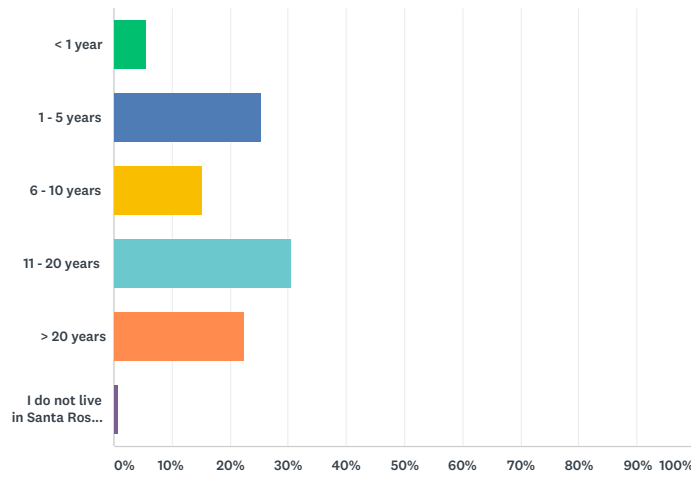

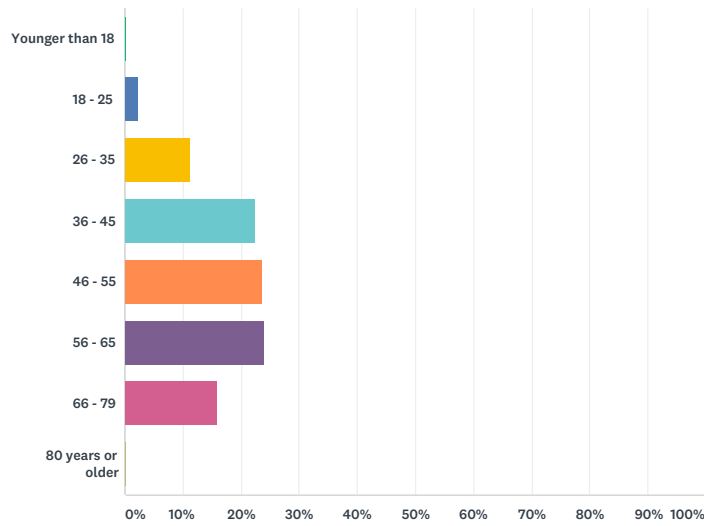

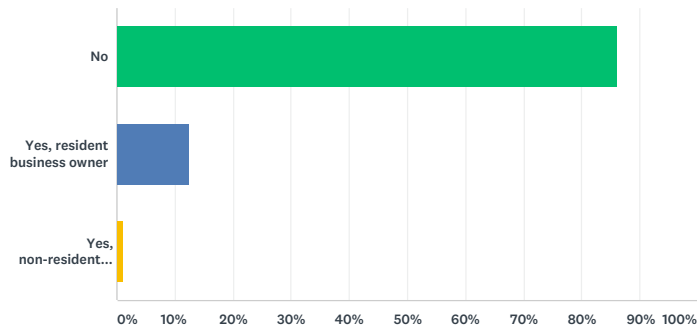

### Q6 Are you a business owner in District 4?

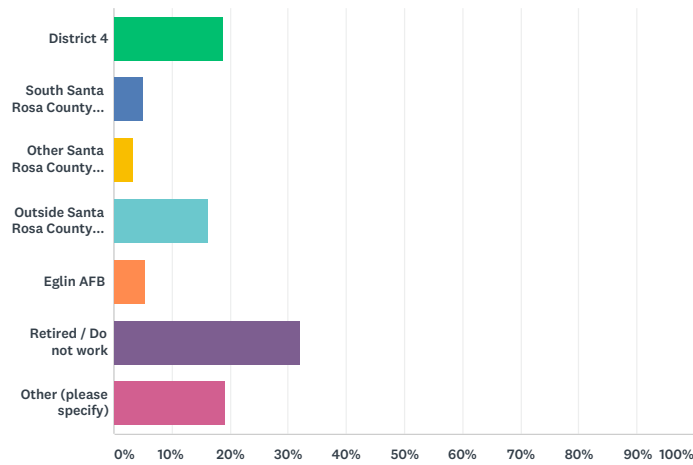

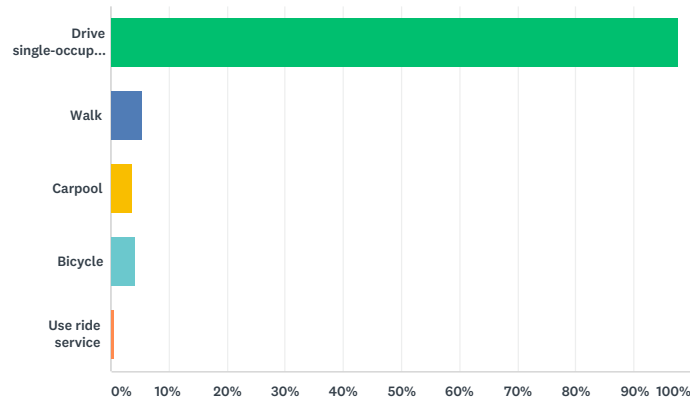

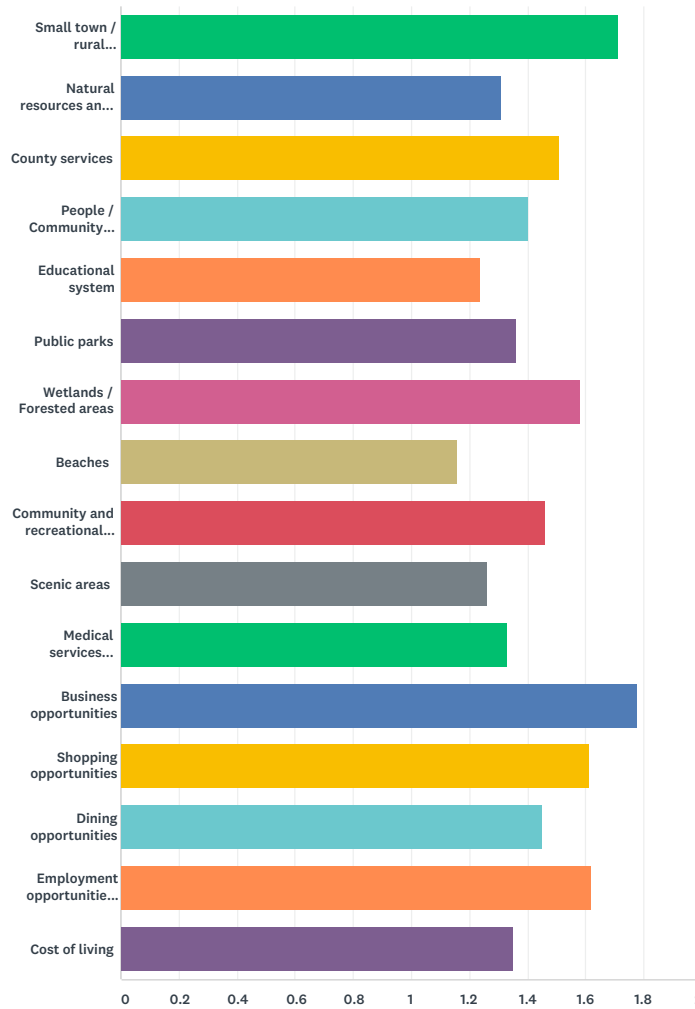

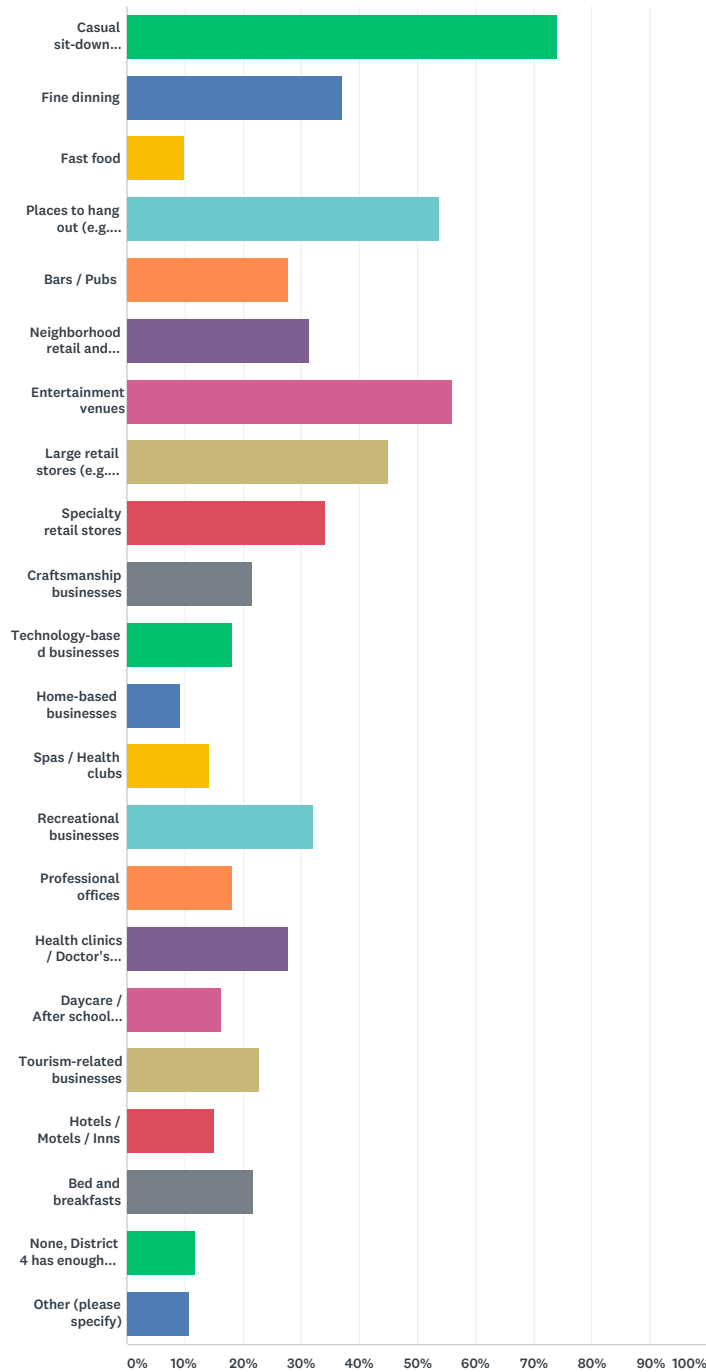

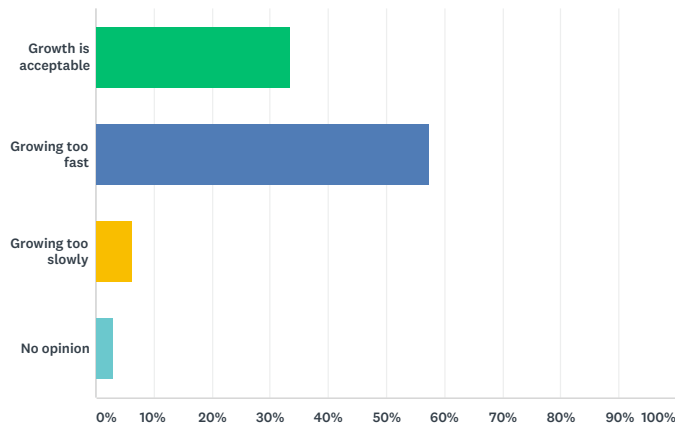

Q15 In your opinion, which statement best describes the residential rate of growth in District 4?

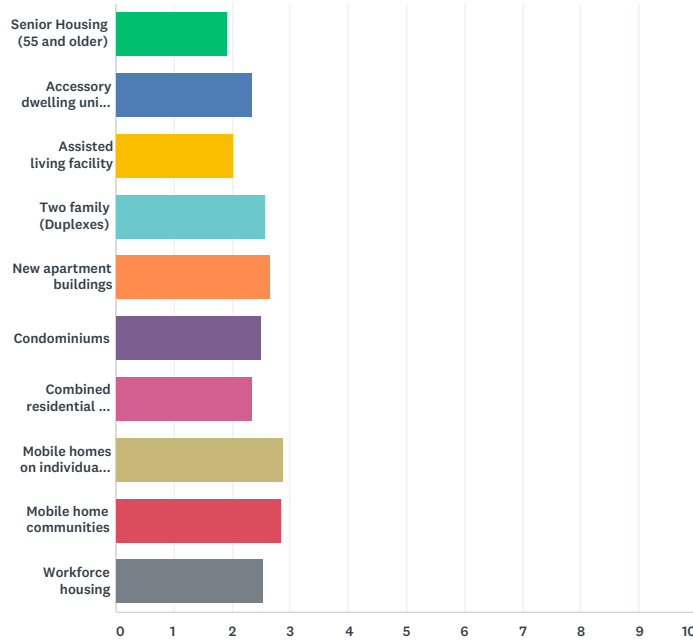

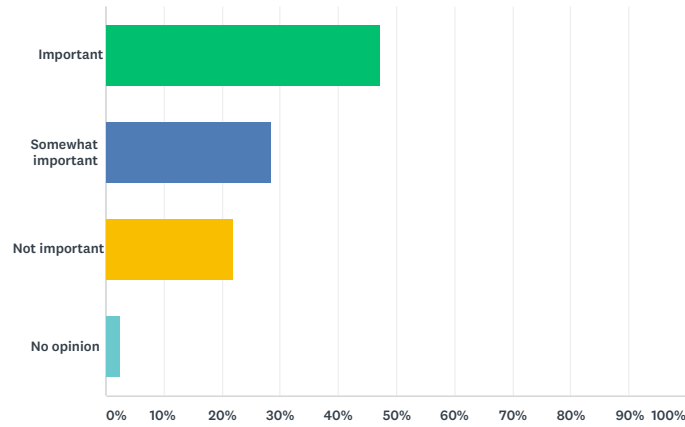

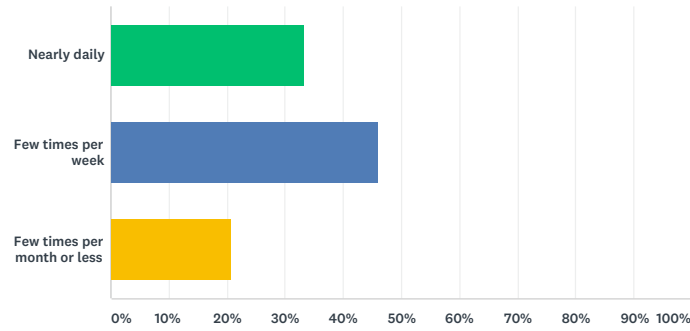

Q18 How frequently do you or members of your household visit businesses outside of District 4?

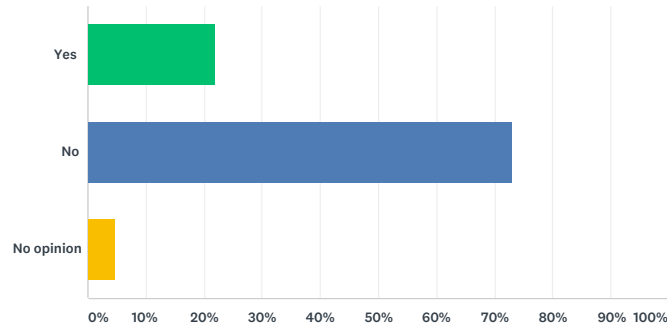

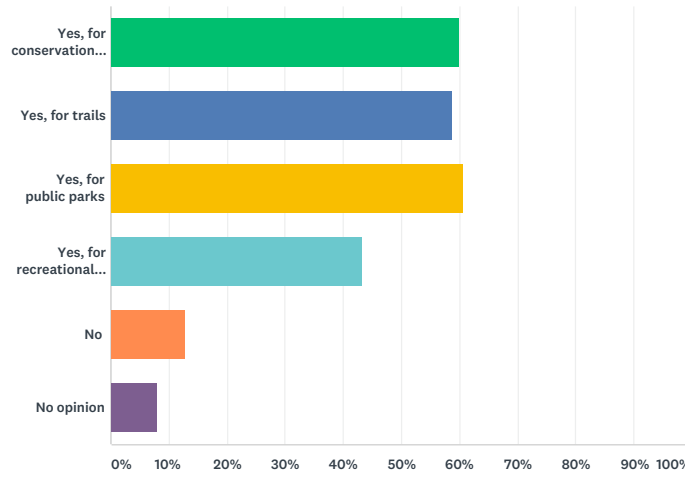

Q26 Do you support the acquisition of lands and easements by the County? (Check all that apply)

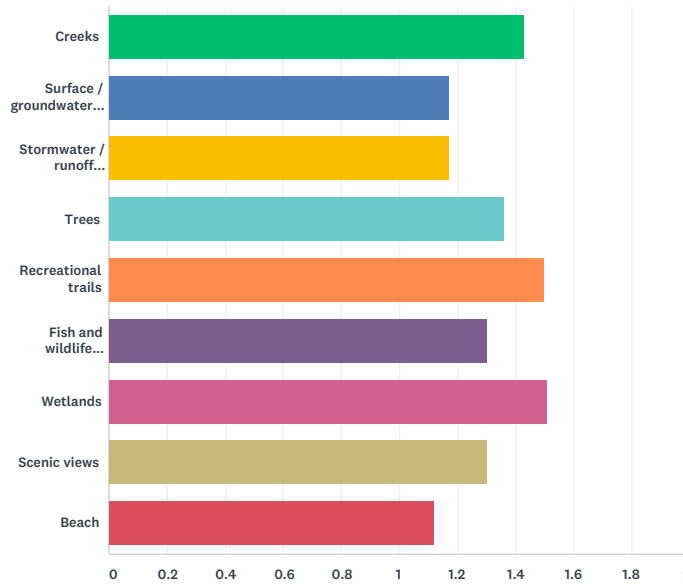

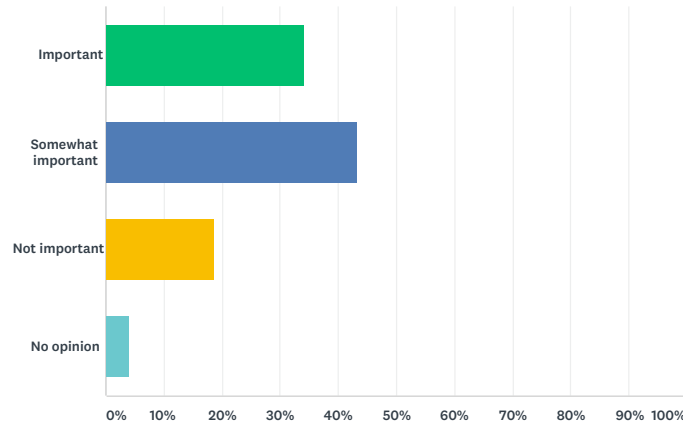

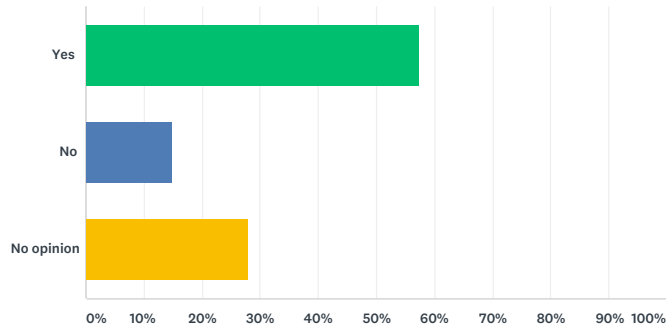

### Q29 Would you support zoning ordinance amendments to change the boundaries of the Town Center District?

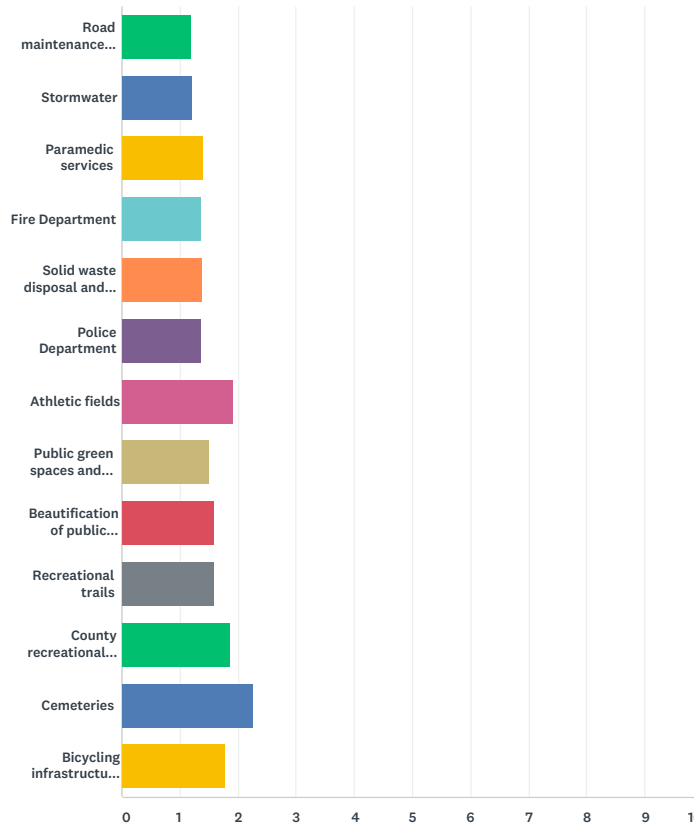
